

WAYPOINT SEALANTS PRODUCTS FOR MARBLE

MARBLE

MARBLE, Marble has been used to make statues and provide flooring since ancient times and is frequently used as a countertop material because of its beautiful, smooth, cool surface. Marble is less porous and slightly stronger than limestone, but softer and less durable than granite. Since marble is more porous than granite, it is more susceptible to staining from cooking and spills and should be sealed.

Sealant Considerations: Waypoint makes several sealers for protecting Marble. Each will provide protection from water while also providing stain resisting properties.

WPR600-Stain Guard Plus, solvent-based, penetrating, repels water, strong stain resistance including red wine, oils, strong beading, slight darkening.

WPN900-Stain Tuff Sealer, water-based, penetrating; repels water and oil (motor/cooking), nature stains caused by oils, strong beading, slight darkening.
